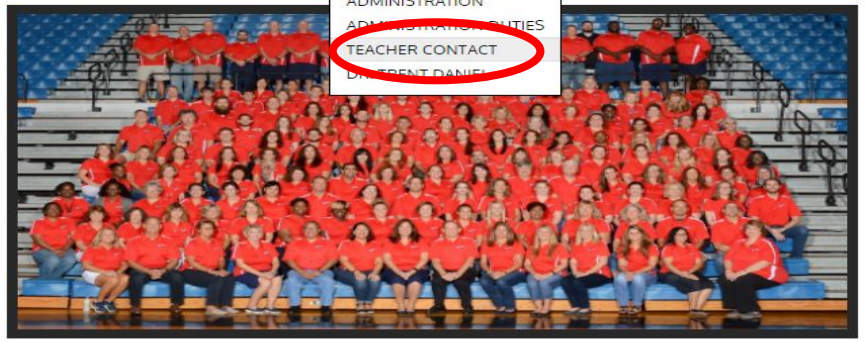

Contacting Your Child's Teacher

- Email is best (emails are found on the 'Staff' page of the LB website)

- Check out ECampus

Most teachers are uploading information to ECampus and have tutorials or additional information stored there for student use.

- Sign up for Skyward notifications and monitor (but NOT every day)

- Allow teachers and other staff members at least 24 hours to respond to questions.

- Your child's teacher will have the BEST information on how to support their learning and ultimately their success within the classroom.

College & Career Readiness and Advisement

-College & Career Expo (September 13th)

-SAT/PSAT School Day (October 11th) All students will test.

-ASVAB (November 9th) Free aptitude evaluation- great for determining areas of potential career success.

-Financial Aid Lab Night (November 16th)

-AP Potential/PSAT Score Review (January 23rd) PSAT scores will be reviewed and information about Advanced Placement provided.

Academic Support
