1. SSC College Night

3. ASVAB

This Vocational Aptitude Battery instrument aids students in determining which vocations they are most suited for coupled with their primary interest areas. The ASVAB is free and given at LBHS during the school day on November 9. Preregistration is necessary in Bldg 7 prior to the end of October. Listen for announcements.

Transcripts

If you wish to request a transcript, complete the transcript request form in the Building 1 Guidance Office. Your first and last transcripts are free; all others are \$1.00. Upon receipt of your request, there is a three-day processing period.
