Getting Ahead vs. Getting Caught Up

Summer School

- ▶ Student has received a grade of 'F' for at least one semester of a course OR
- ▶ Student has lost credit for at least one credit of a course due to absences.
- ▶ May not be used to advance.
- ▶ Attendance is mandatory.
- ▶ Limited to core academic courses
- ▶ ***Not recommended for athletes wishing to compete at the collegiate level.***

Virtual School (SCVS or FLVS)

- ▶ May be used to retrieve lost credit due to a grade of 'F' or excessive absences.
- ▶ May be used to advance in credits.
- ▶ Seminole Virtual for Summer Courses requires counselor approval.
- ▶ Preferred method for athletes.

**Please note that SCVS will not approve the start of an AP course during the summer
