- 1) Abide by all rules on the reverse side of this page.
- 2) I will not transport another student in my vehicle without notarized written permission from his/her parents.
- 3) I will park my vehicle only in the **DESIGNATED STUDENT PARKING LOT**.
- 4) I understand that **at no time shall I put my parking STICKER on any vehicle other than the one named in this application.**
- 5) As a Senior, I understand I may not use my vehicle to transport non-seniors off campus for lunch.
- 6) I will not allow another student to drive/or have access to my vehicle, and will keep my vehicle locked at all times.
- 7) I will operate my vehicle in a safe and courteous manner and respect the safety of other drivers and pedestrians on campus and while entering and exiting school grounds.
- 8) I will abide by the **5 mph** speed limit on campus as well as all Florida laws for safe driving. Additionally, I will follow the direction of any faculty, staff, security personnel or police monitoring traffic in the school parking lot.

If any violations/misuse of this parking sticker occurs:

- 1) Driver will lose parking privilege immediately for the remainder of the school year.
- 2) Vehicle will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.

WARNING: Any violation of the Code of Student Conduct which occurs in or around my vehicle may result in the termination of my parking privileges.

REGULATIONS FOR PARKING AT LAKE BRANTLEY HIGH SCHOOL

_____ 1. All vehicles must be registered with a VALID PARKING PASS. Passes MUST be displayed in front Windshield at ALL times.

_____ **IT IS THE STUDENTS RESPONSIBILITY
TO DISPLAY AN AUTHORIZED PARKING PASS IN THEIR PARKED VEHICLE.
IF YOU HAVE TO USE A DIFFERENT VEHICLE YOU MUST REPORT IT TO THE ASSIGNED PERSON IN
BUILDING 1 BEFORE FIRST PERIOD ON THE DAY YOU DRIVE**

_____ 2. Students may NOT park in teacher parking areas OR Brantley South. Vehicles must be parked in only one parking space between the lines. Visitor and handicapped parking is designated and students or faculty may not utilize these spaces for personal use. Parking in a tow away zone or in faculty or administration parking areas (numbered spots) will result in towing of the student's vehicle at owner's expense on the first offense. Any student who does not have a parking pass will have his/her vehicle towed on the second violation.

_____ **3. STUDENTS WHO PARK IN UNAUTHORIZED AREAS WILL BE SUBJECT TO
DISCIPLINARY ACTION AND/OR LOSS OF DRIVING PRIVILEGES.**

_____ 4. Students are **not allowed** to loiter in the parking lot. Students may go to their vehicles only before and after school or during lunch if they leave campus. Students are not to use their vehicles as an alternative to a locker or a lunch room. Vehicles will remain locked at all times.

_____ 5. All students who leave campus for lunch, or those on early release OJT, must display their appropriate pass and picture ID to the administrator OR security staff on duty. OJT students MAY NOT return to campus upon their departure EXCEPT for school programs. Under NO circumstances may the OJT students transport any LB student to or from our campus.

_____ **ONLY SENIORS WITH LUNCH PASSES MAY LEAVE CAMPUS FOR LUNCH**

_____ 6. Vehicles with **OUT OF STATE** or **TEMPORARY DEALER TAGS** will not be issued parking passes.

_____ 7. The fee for a parking pass is \$ 70.00 yearly (Senior and OJT). If the pass is lost, a replacement pass will cost \$ 5.00 . Season ACTIVITY parking fee is \$35.00. Passes lost for ACTIVITY will not be replaced. If you change vehicles, you MUST register the new vehicle prior to driving that vehicle on campus.

_____ 8. All students will operate their vehicles in a safe and courteous manner and obey the **5 MPH speed limit** on school grounds. This will be strictly enforced. No student may drive on or across the median or landscaped areas in the parking lot. No student may enter or exit the parking lot except on the paved driveway. Any violators of these policies shall receive disciplinary action and be subject to loss of driving privileges.

_____ **9. ALL VEHICLES WILL BE ISSUED ONE WARNING IF THERE IS A PARKING OR DRIVING VIOLATION, UNLESS SPECIFICALLY STATED OTHERWISE. ANY FURTHER VIOLATIONS WILL RESULT IN THE FOLLOWING: (1) LOSS OF PARKING PRIVILEGES FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SCHOOL YEAR, (2) HAVING THE VEHICLE TOWED AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE, (3) SUSPENSION, (4) TRAFFIC CITATION, (5) OTHER DISCIPLINARY ACTION OR A COMBINATION OF THESE CONSEQUENCES.**

I have read and initialed the above regulations and I agree to abide by them. I also agree that I will be subject to any or all of the listed consequences if I violate any of these regulations.

CRITERIA FOR OBTAINING AND MAINTAINING A LAKE BRANTLEY PARKING PASS

Permanent revocation of parking privilege: **three** or more in-school suspensions, **two** or more out-of-school suspensions, or **any** major discipline infraction.

Suspension of parking privilege up to 9 weeks: **four** referrals to the office, **repeated** minor parking violations, **minor** discipline infractions, or **three** or more Tardies to the class period following your lunch.

Littering: Seniors & OJT students are responsible for disposing of trash in a responsible manner. This includes passengers riding in your vehicle.

Students are **NOT** entitled to a refund due to discipline violations.
